Virginia Tech is a comprehensive, four-year, public university with over 25,000 undergraduate students who choose from over 100 majors in eight colleges: the College of Liberal Arts and Human Sciences, the College of Science, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, the College of Architecture and Urban Studies, the College of Engineering, the Pamplin College of Business, the College of Natural Resources and Environment, and the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine. Virginia Tech competes at the NCAA Division I level and is a member of the Atlantic Coast Conference. There are over 900 student clubs and organizations on campus. Academic opportunities include the Honors College, Cooperative Education, and Study Abroad.

**Other Helpful Information:**

Undergraduate Admissions uses two application platforms - the Common Application and the Coalition Application. Early Decision deadline is November 1, Early Action deadline is December 1, and Regular Decision is January 15. We recommend applicants apply by the Early Action deadline to give themselves the best chance for admission. Spring and Summer Semester applications are only open to transfer students and Freshman are only admitted in Fall Semester.

Graduate Admissions has their own application platform. Each program has a different deadline, so it is important that you review the program website to understand their own deadline, requirements, and necessary application materials.

The Virginia Tech Language and Culture Institute has a pathway program for undergraduate students who do not meet the English language requirements. The AdvantageVT program is designed as a one-year program and students take both ESL courses to improve English as well as first year undergraduate courses. At the end of the year, successful students will have earned between 15-18 university level credits that will count towards their undergraduate degree at Virginia Tech.
