### Other Helpful Information:

Johnson & Wales University offers the English Learning & Cultural Academy for students who have not taken an English proficiency test or if their score is not high enough. English proficiency is not used to determine if a student is accepted or if a student receives a scholarship. These decisions are based on the student's past academic performance (Grade Point Average - GPA).

Students do not need JWU ELCA if they score 105 Duolingo (undergraduate), 110 Duolingo (graduate); 75 TOEFL IBT (undergraduate), 80 TOEFL IBT (graduate); 6.0 IELTS (undergraduate) 6.5 IELTS (graduate).

Our application is free and we use the same application for scholarships.

SAT/ACT welcomed but not required.

Essays are welcomed but not required.

GMAT or GRE are not required if a student has above a 2.84 in their bachelor degree for MOST of our graduate program majors.

JWU provides free transfer credit evaluation and will accept transfer courses that are C or better.
