Scholarship Information:

Bluegrass Spirit Scholarship: Main academic scholarship ranging from \$8,000-\$12,500. GPA and SAT/ACT considered. Students must apply for admission by December 1 and must be a freshman undergraduate student.

William C. Parker Diversity Scholarship: Amount varies. Students must apply for admission by December 1 (priority deadline); February 15 (final deadline) - early application is encouraged. To be eligible, students must complete the William C. Parker scholarship section of the admission application and provide supporting documents. A 300-word essay is required. Must be a freshman undergraduate student.

International Ambassador Scholarship: Amount ranges from \$3,000-\$16,000. Students must apply for admission by February 15. Application includes a one-page essay describing how you could serve as a student ambassador to the university and one letter of recommendation. Must be international undergraduate freshman or transfer student.
