Scholarship Information:

UWG provides international scholarships called "out-of-state" tuition waivers. While U.S. citizens in Georgia qualify to pay lower "in-state" tuition rates, non-Georgia residents and students from other countries pay "out-of-state tuition," which is three times higher. Our 100% waiver allows international students to pay "in-state tuition," which can save \$11,000 each year. Waivers are renewable and are based on academic merit at the time of application, so apply early! We also offer 1/2 and 1/4 awards.
