We are located within comfortable driving distance to international airports in Indianapolis (1hr), Cincinnati (2hrs), and Chicago (3.5hrs). We offer undergraduate and graduate STEM programs, like Architecture, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Math, and Physics, but Ball State University is actually considered the Indiana leader in non-STEM-related study. Scholarship Information:

For undergraduate students, we provide scholarships (\$2,000-\$8,000 for four years) automatically if GPA is 3.00 or higher. The higher the GPA, the higher the scholarship.

For 75% of graduate students, Ball State University offers full-time Graduate Assistantships for which graduate students work 20 hours a week and receive a majority waiver of their tuition cost and a stipend determined by the department. Part-time assistants work 10 hours a week and receive a waiver for 55% of their tuition cost and a stipend.
