CU Denver offers rolling admissions at the undergraduate level, and will get a decision back to you within 10 business days. Graduate program deadlines and processing varies by program.

English Language Proficiency

There are many different ways you can meet the English Language Proficiency requirement:

- Graduation from CU Denver's ESL Academy
- TOEFL: 79 with intermediate/fair mark in each sub-score
- IELTS: 6.5 with 5.5 in each sub-score
- Duolingo: 105
