International student merit scholarships are based on previous academic performance. Scholarships are awarded at the time of admission decision after all required materials has been received.

**Freshman Scholarships** | \$14,000 – \$21,000 per year for up to four years of undergraduate study

**Transfer Scholarships** | \$10,000 – \$18,000 per year for undergraduate studies

**PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP:** \$2,000

Awarded to transfer students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, in addition to the transfer scholarship listed above; proof of PTK membership must be submitted with admission application

**Canada Provincial Scholarship** | \$1,000 – \$5,000 additional scholarship money
