Scholarship Information:

<p>Each year, a limited number of non-resident tuition fee waivers are available to undergraduate international students (F-1 visa holders) on a competitive basis.</p> <p>Minimum Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Only students who are seeking to earn a degree from CSU, Chico may apply. Short-term, non-degree seeking students are not eligible to apply. -Only admitted or continuing students may apply. -The minimum qualifying cumulative grade point average (GPA) is 3.3 (or the equivalent). -In addition to scholastic merit (grades), all applicants must demonstrate financial need. <p>Duration of Award:</p> <p>Non-resident tuition fee waivers are granted for one academic year (fall and spring semesters). Recipients are required to maintain an eligible GPA to continue receiving the award in the second semester. Qualified recipients may re-apply each year to continue receiving the award.
