



The College of Central Florida offers over 150 academic pathways for undergraduate studies, including 2-year occupational degrees, 2+2 transfer pathway program, and 4-year bachelor's degrees. Fields of study include Art, Business, Communication, Education, Health Sciences, Humanities, Industry and Manufacturing, Public Safety, STEM, Social and Behavioral Sciences, and Human Services.

CF's largest campus is located in the safe, suburban community of Ocala, Florida, which is 1.5 hours away from Orlando and Daytona Beach. Student housing is available at the College Square Apartments, which is equipped with amenities that provides a feeling of home away from home.

CF Associates degree graduates are guaranteed transfer admission to a Florida public state university. CF has partnerships with University of Central Florida (Orlando), University of South Florida (Tampa), Florida A&M University (Tallahassee), and University of Florida Online.

Other Helpful Information:

Students begin at CF at all levels of English fluency. TOEFL 61 and IELTS 5.5 test scores are accepted but not required for admission because CF offers English as a Second Language for Academic Purposes (ESL/EAP) courses. Students admitted without passing English proficiency test scores take the English Reading and Writing placement tests on the first day of orientation. Students meeting cut-off score begin college-level coursework immediately. Students not meeting the cut-off score will be enrolled in the ESL/EAP courses, and their scores determine placement. CF offers two levels of English as a Second Language for Academic Purposes (ESL/EAP) courses. Each level can be completed in one semester, and each credit costs the same as college credit course.
