Scholarship Information:

Undergraduate scholarship: All admitted students, regardless of citizenship, are considered for the same merit scholarships. Merit scholarships typically range from \$14,000-20,000 per year. We also have a small amount of need-based financial aid that international students can apply for by completing the CSS Profile.
Clark does have one very competitive scholarship, the Presidential Scholarship, which does cover tuition, room, and board. This scholarship is only awarded to 3-5 students per year. Students who are awarded the Presidential Scholarship are responsible for the student activities fee, health insurance, books, travel expenses, and personal expenses.
